Horsham community meeting – operational and recovery info



Following a damaging overnight tornado, the Horsham community are invited to a digital and in-person meeting on Monday evening (7 December) to detail recovery and support options.

The weather system hit around 1am, with numerous homes seriously damaged and four left uninhabitable. It saw Victoria State Emergency Service (VICSES) volunteers called to a total of 102 incidents in the space of 24 hours.

Consequently, **VICSES** will join **Horsham Rural City Council** at **Horsham Primary School** Rasmussen Campus at **7:30pm**, for a special community meeting. It will take place in the gym – accessible via the Albert Street gateway.
