Meet VICSES' first ever DUAL unit Controller

An exciting and unique development in the state's south-west has seen two VICSES units headed by the same dedicated volunteer.

Current Heywood controller Charlie Debono has put up his hand to head the Portland unit, after existing unit controller Bernadette 'Bernie' Stiles' has decided not to renew another for another term after four years in the role.

Bernie remains a passionate member of the Portland unit, which is one of just two VICSES units in the South-West region that specialise in high angle rescues. The unit also welcomed a renovation grant recently thanks to the hard work of Deputy Controller Scott McFarlane.

Portland is familiar territory for Mr Debono, who was the VICSES Portland unit controller there between 2015 and 2016, and has been at the helm of Heywood for the last two years. Membership has also seen a boost at Heywood, thanks to a joint recruitment drive with a local CFA brigade.

Charlie is hoping that Portland can also get a boost in new participation in coming months.

It has been a busy 12 months for both local units, with Portland members attending 70 Requests for Assistance (RFAs) and Heywood called to 52 RFAs. In that time, members assisted the community after road accidents, trees falling on roads or properties, flood damage after rain, and more.
