Hazardous objects descriptions

1. We can buy many different foods in these containers, after we throw them away, they often turn rusty (a brown colour).

Tin can

2. These are worn by babies because they are too young to use the toilet.

Nappy

3. Usually these grow, or are found, in the garden or park.

Tree branch

4. Poisonous liquid which we often use on the garden to keep away pests/bugs.

Chemicals

5. We use these to build fences and gates.

Wooden plank

6. An animal that has been dead for some time.

mouse

7. We use the toilet for this.

Poo

8. A medical instrument, used to inject fluids into the body or draw them out.

Syringe / needle











9. When we drop a bottle or jar what happens.
